### **Preparing for Remote Monitoring**

Remote monitoring is a new technology that is being used to help people live safely in their home without having staff physically present. It can make an incredible difference in people's lives by:

- Helping them live more independently
- Providing oversight to ensure health and safety
- Enhancing staff effectiveness

This technology does not replace the support provided by people, but does give support workers more time and flexibility to spend with those who have the most need.

Aveyron is excited to share that our Milwaukee home will begin utilizing remote monitoring for overnight supervision. Cameras, motion sensors, and other safeguards will be set up to allow supervision from a remote support team, which will allow for notification should there be a need for physical staff to respond.

We look forward to the increased use of this type of technology throughout the company in the future.

### **New Payroll Company**

Aveyron has begun the process of switching over to a new Payroll System, **Paychex**. This new system will bring staff some extra benefits such as FinFit, an application to help with budgets and finance planning. It will also allow staff to log in and print out past timecards, make direct deposit changes and request time off, just to name a few.
