Aveyron supports staff wellness!

The Disability Workforce Crisis

Association of Residential Resources in Minnesota (ARRM) states that since October 2021, more than 30% of all positions in disability services have remained unfilled and 170 group homes have closed due to staffing shortages.

Aveyron is not immune to the staffing shortage. While some employers can choose to close for a few hours or days, that is not an option for us. Our clients rely on us for their service needs. We have, however, been able to add more sites that use remote monitoring for overnight coverage. This frees up those staff to fill other hours within the company, but not all clients can be successful without staff on site. If a client requests one-on-one staffing, Aveyron must consider discharge. We simply do not have enough employees to meet that expectation.

Although competitive in our industry, our base pay of \$17.75/hour Monday-Friday and \$19.75/hour on weekends is not enough when you consider that our staff are responsible for the lives of 1-4 people every day. Our fees are set, and we don't have the ability to raise our per diems. Aveyron relies on

legislative action to grant salary increases.

Without government funding to provide competitive wages for our workers, there will be ongoing difficulty retaining and recruiting workers. Who will be left to care for vulnerable adults?




