On March 28, Aveyron Home's staff Amber Winn and Molley O'Malley attended Association of Residential Resources in Minnesota (ARRM) Day at the Capital to lobby for increased wages. Once again, the staff of Aveyron Homes is **TAKING ACTION** and letting our elected officials know how they can best support healthcare workers!

Soon, the House and Senate leadership will be working on setting their budget targets. We are adding our voice to the call, urging leadership to prioritize the Human Service budget. The care that healthcare professionals provide is essential to the community, therefore it is crucial that wage increases are prioritized for those working in healthcare. We need the support of the governments to alleviate the crises that disability services are facing. It is up to the state to provide the necessary tools, opportunities, and service structure that allows us to continue caring for people with disabilities.

#### **AVEYRON HOMES WELCOMES NURSING STUDENTS!**



#### **Roasted Carrots**

By Simple Recipes



Roasted carrots are an easy and delicious side dish that pairs well with any meal! To make this recipe, you will need:

#### **Ingredients**

- 1 1/2 pounds young carrots (about 5 inches each), clean and pat dry
- o 1 red onion, sliced
- o 2 tbsp. of minced garlic
- 1 tbsp. chopped fresh rosemary
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- Salt and pepper to taste

#### Method

Preheat the oven to 400°F. Line a roasting pan with aluminum foil.

Toss the carrots with sliced red onion, garlic, fresh rosemary, olive oil and salt and pepper. Place ingredients on lined pan.

Roast at 400°F for 30-40 mins until browned and tender.

Roasted carrots are best served right away! If you do have leftovers, refrigerate them in an air-tight container for 3 to 4 days.
