Standing Strong Through Statewide Challenges

Over the past several months, Minnesota has been working to uncover and address widespread fraud in Medicaid-funded programs that support people with disabilities and other vulnerable populations. Federal and state authorities have charged multiple individuals and organizations with billing for services that were not provided, particularly in programs like the Housing Stabilization Services Program and others tied to Medicaid. Recent reporting indicates investigators believe a significant portion of funds—potentially half of the roughly \$18 billion spent on 14 programs since 2018—may have been fraudulently billed.

The Association of Residential Resources in Minnesota (ARRM)—a nonprofit advocacy organization representing nearly 200 provider organizations that deliver home and community-based disability services—has been engaged in this issue. ARRM's mission is to strengthen the disability service system, support providers, and promote quality care for people with disabilities across the state.

ARRM has expressed concern about statewide actions in response to these fraud investigations—such as pauses in Medicaid payments and audits that could slow funding for legitimate providers. The organization has emphasized the need for accountability and transparency while also highlighting that broad payment pauses may put undue strain on care providers and the individuals they support.

At Aveyron Homes, we want to be clear: **we are not under investigation.** However, we recognize that fraud in the system diverts funds that could be used to improve wages, supports, and services for Direct Support Professionals and the people they care for every day. Ensuring accountability helps protect the integrity of disability services—and supports our goals of providing quality care, a consistent workforce, and meaningful support for our residents.
